Prof. D. K. Bae is Professor and Chairman of the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery at Kyunghee University Medical Center. His main subjects of interest are total knee joint replacement in primary and revision cases and arthroscopic surgery in knee joint.

He was past President of Korean Knee Society and Korean Arthroscopic Society.

Dr. W. K. Chung is the Director, Nepean Joint Replacement and Reconstruction Center and Visiting Orthopaedic Surgeon, Jamison Hospital. He has been a member of the Advisory Board, Science Centre, Beijing, China and part of the Executive Committee, NSW Branch, Australian Orthopaedic Association

He has been involved with extensive teaching programmes worldwide and has significantly influenced training in joint replacement across Asia. He is the anchor behind the Delta group, which promotes knowledge and practice of hip and knee arthroplasty in the Asia-Pacific region. More than 1500 Asian surgeons have attended educational meetings conducted by the Delta group in Sydney and various parts of Asia.



Dr. Bharat Mody, a specialist knee surgeon, is the Director & Chief Arthroplasty Surgeon at the Centre for Knee Surgery (CKS), Vadodara. After completing a successful stint as an orthopaedic surgeon and executive vice-president of Mayo Hospital, Vadodara he founded the Centre for Knee Surgery.

He has to his credit two theses and over 16 publications in reputed international journals of Orthopaedics. He has now been inducted on the international executive committee of the Asia Pacific Arthroplasty Society to represent India.

Dr. Chit Ranawat is the Chairman - Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, Lenox Hill Hospital. He is also Chairman, Ranawat Orthopaedic Center, and Ranawat Orthopaedic Research Foundation at Lenox Hill. He is a professor of Clinical Orthopaedic Surgery at Weill Medical College of Cornell University, the New York Hospital and Hospital for Special Surgery.

Many of the innovative design breakthroughs and applications of total joint replacements during the past two decades can be attributed to Dr. Ranawat's outstanding research. As a leading researcher and clinician, Dr. Ranawat is the author of more than 170 articles, as well as numerous textbook chapters on surgery of the hip, knee, rheumatoid neck, wrist, and foot. In addition, he is a founding member of the Journal of Arthroplasty.



Dr. Rami Sorial is a Visiting Medical Officer at Nepean Hospital, Hawkesbury District Hospital and Nepean Private Hospital. He is also the chairman of New South Wales AOA Regional Training Committee and a member of the AOA State Executive.

He is actively involved in research and is currently working on:

- Racial Characterisation of Articular Wear in Osteoarthritis
- Use of the Frontal Epicondylar Axis and Transepicondylar Axis in Total Knee Arthroplasty for Component Alignment
- Defining the Bone Implant Interface in Cementless Total Hip Arthroplasty Using MRI Scanning for Various Design Principles
